A Day Camp T-shirt will be provided for each boy as part of the camp fee. This shirt, along with weather-appropriate clothing, will be the official Day Camp uniform and must be worn to camp each day, dirty or clean. Boys need sturdy shoes, hats, water to drink, sunscreen, bathing suit, and a sack lunch. Please label all items with the boy's name.



Boys should arrive between 8:00 and 9:00a.m. for check-in with their Den leader. Scheduled program begins at 9:00a.m..



Camp-wide flag ceremonies are held to open and close camp each day. Please assemble by units at these times.



Dens will rotate through a variety of stations each day: team sports, games, nature, crafts, archery, fishing and den time. The activity at each station will be different each day of camp.



It is the responsibility of each boy to bring lunch from home each day of camp. Care should be taken to see that food items can safely withstand the heat of Day Camp. Each boy will put their lunch in the provided coolers that have their den's lunches in. Please do not bring glass or metal containers.



Day Camp will host some form of entertainment for the parents at the Friday Closing Ceremony. Families will be told what to bring during Day Camp. All dens are to assemble at the flagpole for the show.



Requests for refunds should be submitted in writing to the Day Camp Director and will be given for extreme circumstances; there will be no refunds due to inclement weather.



The camp Trading Post provides a wide assortment of souvenirs and items for sale. The Trading Post is open during lunch and at Friday's Closing Ceremony.



All Scouts are to be checked out as they are picked up at the end of the day. Den Leaders must remain at camp until each of their boys have been checked out. Parents should pick their boys up no later than 4 p.m.



Visitors are always welcome at Day Camp. All visitors must check-in and check-out with the camp headquarters.
